

SHIP MONARCH OF THE SEA.—The ship *Monarch of the Sea*, Capt. GARDNER, arrived in this port yesterday, from Pensacola, and was towed up by the tow-boat *Conqueror*. The *Monarch of the Sea* measures 240 feet on deck, and 40 feet beam; her tonnage is 2,500 tons, and she is capable of carrying 7,000 bales of cotton on eighteen and a half feet water, and is rigged on Capt. HOLMES' new plan. The *M.* has been for the last month at Pensacola, testing the new dry dock for the United States Government, for which she received some \$20,000. Capt. GARDNER states that his ship was taken out some three hundred feet on land in twenty hours, by the new dock and railway, and replaced in about the same time.—*New-Orleans Bulletin*, Jan. 26.
